

## 2016 North Dakota State Tax Information

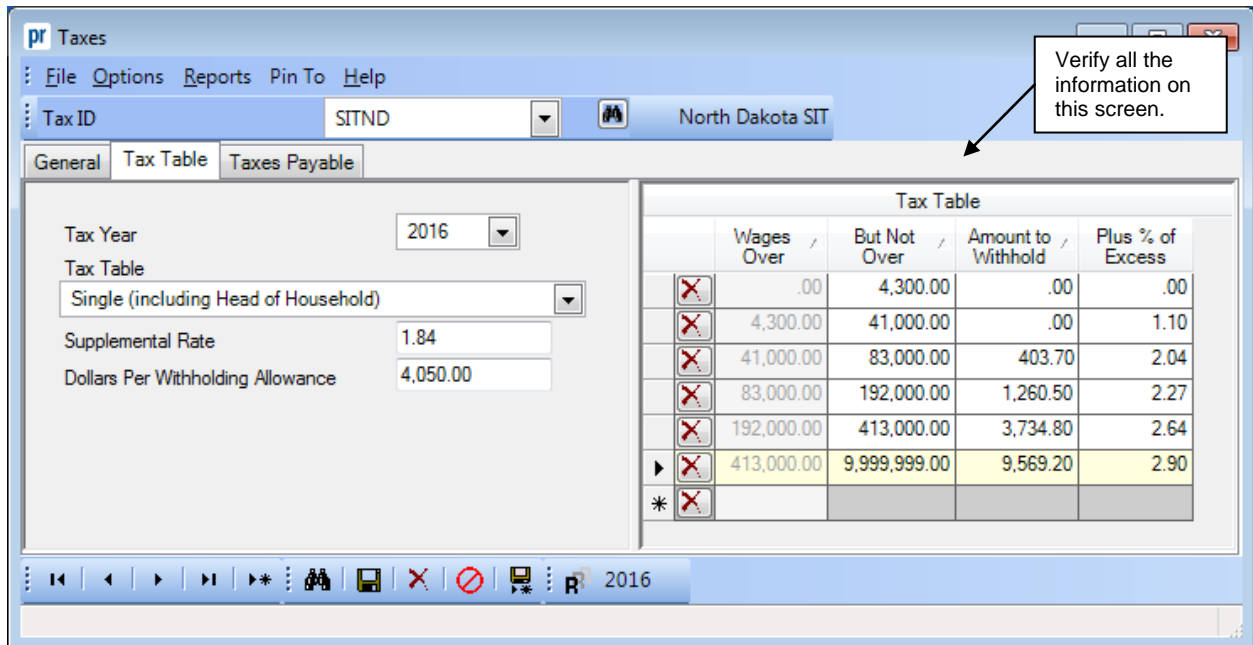

The Taxable Wage Base for 2016 has increased to \$37,200. To verify the information, either key in the Tax ID or search for the ID in the Taxes option. On the Tax Table tab, enter 2016 in the Tax Year. When prompted to copy the previous year tax table, select **Yes**. The Tax Rate and Limit will reflect the values from the previous year and should be edited to be the appropriate figures if necessary. For some employers, the limit field may be blank – contact Job Service if you are unsure how to set up your district.
